Public Forum
March 13, 2008 IAKSS**

Mr. Bill Ward, head custodian at Cardinal Valley Elementary, came to discuss the needs at his school. He reported there were many electrical problems, especially with the amount of new technology in the building. Circuit overloads are frequent. The HVAC unit had a number of parts in the system fail and the turnaround time is approximately 1-2 weeks on repairs. He feels that the maintenance staff and the administration at the school are both doing a good job keeping things running, but the systems need replacing. He came to the meeting to be a voice for the school and let the committee know of the needs at the school.

Bill Wallace discussed with him the process the Committee had used to determine the order in the facilities plan. Mr. Ward reported that he had spoken with a team of architects back in September about building conditions. It was indicated that the district is aware that many of the building components are nearing the end of their life cycle and that is why CVE has been placed on the DFP in the first biennium.

Mr. Ward thanked the committee for their consideration.
