

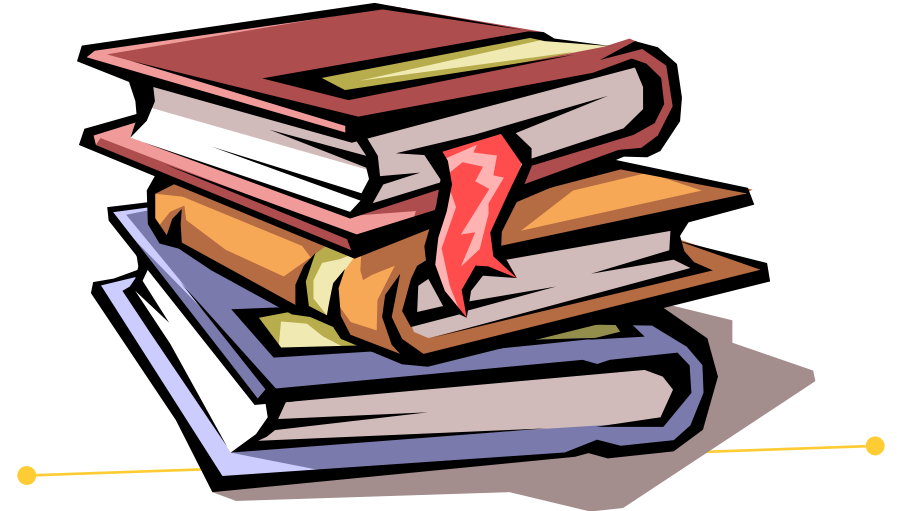

# SATURDAY DETENTION

The purpose of Saturday Detention is to provide a positive, worthwhile, educational experience and a meaningful misbehavior deterrent for those students who have violated school rules. Saturday Detention will be used as a disciplinary action option, in lieu of out of school suspension, for students who have broken the school rules. In some instances, the principal will assign out of school suspension instead of Saturday Detention. Saturday Detention will prevent students from losing instructional time, keeping them in school.

Students who attend Saturday Detention will be given the opportunity to do homework, make-up or remedial work, under the supervision of a certified teacher.

## Operational Procedures

The Saturday Detention Program will be in operation at Martin Luther King Academy for Excellence, 2200 Liberty Road which is located directly behind Eastside Center for Applied Technology . A specific calendar of dates of operation is attached. The program will operate from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

Seats will be reserved on a first call-in basis, as there are only sixty (60) seats reserved. After the maximum is reached, other students will be referred to the next week's detention. An assignment to Saturday Detention will substitute for one(1) full day suspension. Students should be referred when they commit an offense that would result in or require an out of school suspension. Saturday Detention is not to compete with or replace S.A.F.E. programs.

Please state student's name, school, referring principal and student's infraction.

### **NO ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE TAKEN ON FRIDAY.**

Monday of the following week the Saturday Detention Program will send each school a report regarding students in attendance the previous Saturday.

## Saturday Detention Rules

1. Administrator assigns students for disciplinary reasons.
2. The parent notification will be the responsibility of the administrator assigning the student to Saturday Detention.
3. If an emergency arises and the student cannot attend, the parent must contact the student's school principal. If the reasons are acceptable the detention will be rescheduled by the school principal.
4. The doors will open at 8:00 a.m. and close at 8:10 a.m.
5. Students should have an assignment from their teachers. If the student does not have an assignment they will given an alternative assignment by the supervisor.
6. The supervisor will review rules and guidelines for students at the beginning of detention.
7. If a student finishes all of his/her work, the detention supervisor may assign additional work.
8. If a student refuses to work, he/she may be assigned an additional day of Saturday Detention.

### **Refusal to Attend**

Saturday Detention is a disciplinary option in lieu of suspension. It should be viewed as an alternative to suspension. Refusal to attend or tardiness without an acceptable excuse may result in the assignment to an additional Saturday Detention or suspension from school.
