New Business

- Introductions – Everyone introduced themselves.
- Review of Tax Initiative Talking Points (HO)
 - The nickel tax is also used to pay the debt we incur from our increased bonding capacity.
 - Proof of future revenue is necessary prior to being allowed to bond.
- Discussion of Possible Impact of Initiative on LPC
 - With the nickel tax for facilities added, we will hopefully be able to add more discretionary projects onto the plan we are developing. (See Maintenance Update).
- Maintenance Update (HO)

- Jack Murrell, Jr. Gilbert, and Marshall Buen shared the report of general maintenance projects completed over last year and also the report of maintenance projects that need to be completed.
- The total cost of these projects is \$42,542,816.00 (However, it should be noted that some of these projects and costs would cease to exist when the schools on the list are included in the renovation schedule).
- The cost has increased over \$19,000,000 in the last 21 months (partly due to new projects being added and increase in cost).
- Maintenance is working diligently to move from a reactive model to a preventative model and is making great strides in doing so.
