## Program Description

The Advanced Teacher Leader Rank One Master of Arts program takes teacher leadership to the school level. This program is for educators who desire flexibility, convenience, individual faculty attention and a strong peer support network as they earn a second Master's degree and advance in teacher leadership roles in their schools and districts. The core courses include advanced relevant instruction in working with diverse learners through collaboration, literacy, and technology, and through using school data for effective decision-making.

## Delivery Options

Classes are offered in two formats:

### Online cohorts

You have the opportunity to be a part of an online community, building relationships throughout multiple core courses

### Blended courses

Courses blend online instruction with face-to-face sessions either at Georgetown College or in your community

## Specialty Areas

### Endorsements

English as a Second Language; Gifted and Talented or Instructional Technology; Certification in Moderate/Severe Disabilities (prior LBD certification required); Cognate (area of emphasis) in English as a Second Language or Autism Spectrum Disorders.

### OR

Create your own specialty area based on your professional development and / or school improvement needs.

## Admission Requirements

- Administrator recommendation
- Earned Master's Degree with minimum 3.0 GPA
- Signed KY Code of Ethics
- Valid Professional Teaching Certificate from Kentucky (If no KY certificate or if certificate has expired, must provide verification of content and professional knowledge through evidence of having passed the appropriate PRAXIS specialty exam and PRAXIS PLT)



## Expected Time to Complete

### Accelerated Option

By choosing to take two courses each term, students may complete the 30-hour program in five terms, or around 18 months.

### Traditional Option

Students have the flexibility to take courses as their schedule permits.
