
In-Person Return

Arrival




- Doors will now open at 7:05
- Same arrival doors will be used
- All student will have temp. check either by staff on duty or thermal temperature scanners.
- School will now begin at 7:35 am .
- Staff will be monitoring students to enter the building safely while maintaining social distancing and wearing masks.

Masks




Everyone – employees, students K-12, contractors and visitors – are required to wear a mask at all times while in the building or on the bus, with the exception of those who have a medical exemption or ARC-determined exemption. Students and staff should only lower their masks while actively eating or drinking. Masks will be provided for students or staff members who do not have one. Gaiters and bandanas do not provide enough protection and are not considered an adequate face covering for FCPS facilities.

Meals



Breakfast will be prepackaged and picked up on the way to classroom and eaten there
Lunches will be preordered, delivered and eaten in classrooms.
Students will keep water bottles at their desks for use throughout the day. They can bring from home or we will provide them.

Class Time



Students will remain in their classroom for the majority of the day.


Special area class instructor will come to the regular classroom for lessons.

When possible, ESL, intervention and other teachers will support student in the regular classroom.

Desk shields will be used in any small groups working at tables and students will not share materials.

Any area/room used for multiple groups will be completely sanitized in-between groups.

Gatherings



- There will be no in-person school-wide assemblies at this time. The plan for in-person school assemblies will be re-evaluated quarterly.

- In-person programs and performances will be suspended through the remainder of the year unless able to access virtually.

- Visitor Access Non-essential visits such as eating lunch with students and volunteering will be suspended for the remainder of the school year.

Chromebooks



-Students need to have their Chromebooks and chargers while learning at school and at home and will need to bring them back and forth to school each day.

-Chromebooks should be fully charged when students arrive at school.

Recess



- Recess will be scheduled daily , one time a day.
- The playground will be divided into zones and each class will remain in their designated zone during play.
- Students must practice good hand hygiene by washing their hands before going out to play and immediately upon returning inside the school building.
- Playground equipment can be used
- Students will be required to wear masks while outdoors.
- Students will keep socially distanced while playing.

Dismissal



- Dismissal will begin at 2:25
- Car riders will be dismissed from their classroom and be picked up in back circle.
- Bus riders will leave the building in a staggered manner and remain socially distanced in hallways.
- Walkers will have a staggered dismissal and exit out side doors or back door.
- Kindergarten walkers must be picked up at the kindergarten front door (near early start playground)

Illness/Symptoms



- Students displaying symptoms will be sent to the sick room for another temperature screening by the nurse or office staff.
- Any student with a fever (temperature higher than 100.4) will remain in the isolated sick room for monitoring by staff ○
Guardians will be called for immediate pickup.

After School




- LEAP will remain suspended and will be re-evaluated once we have safely returned to in person instruction.
- All clubs and afterschool activities will remain suspended unless offered virtually
