

LEAP Behavior Policy

Student Rules:

- Follow directions immediately
- Walk in building
- Keep hands and feet to self
- Respect to students and staff
- Respect to property

So that all the students are on the same type of behavior system, if the rules are not obeyed, the following will be used:

- 1st offense: Warning
- 2nd offense: Put a check mark by their name
- 3rd offense: Another check mark by name/5 minute timeout*
- 4th offense: 3rd check mark by name/10 minute timeout*
- 5th offense: Infraction. Name to Betty Simson, Leap Director.
Parents will be notified and behavior discussed with them.

If three infractions are received in a month's time, the behavior will be reviewed with the school administrator. This may affect participation in enrichment activities.

If behavior that is disruptive to the group continually occurs, and the student makes no attempt to change that behavior, the result could be removal from the LEAP program. This will be at the discretion of the school administrator.

Zero Tolerance Policy

*Sometimes behavior is more severe, or the behavior could be harmful to self or others. There is zero tolerance for hitting or fighting with any student or staff. When this happens, the student will be dealt with on an individual basis with the principal. The student may be suspended for one day from the LEAP Program. After 3 zero tolerance offenses, the student will be permanently removed from the LEAP Program.
