

Parent/Family Q & A - In-Person/Remote Learning

The purpose of this document is to assist families with questions that you may have about the return to in-person learning and remote learning.



Q. Where can information about COE's healthy at school procedures for in-person return be found?

Q. Can I change my child's registration to in-person learning at a later date?

Yes, if circumstances change at home you may switch to in-person or remote. However, we cannot accommodate daily or weekly changes to the learning schedule.

Q. What time does school start and dismiss?

There is a 10 minute schedule change for elementary schools. Students will begin arriving at 7:05am. The tardy bell will ring at 7:35am, and dismissal is at 2:25pm.

Q. Will transportation be provided? What are the bus stops and times?

Yes, transportation will be provided in the morning and afternoon. Please check the bus schedule for times and stops. <https://bit.ly/20-21busroutes>

Q. What is the dress code for in-person learning?

Students are encouraged to adhere to our current dress code and Dress for Success - black, khaki and blue bottoms with solid button down shirts. However, we do understand that we only have a few months of school left, so it may not be feasible to buy clothing right now. Q. Will after school care be provided at Coventry Oak?

Yes, the YMCA will be our after school care provider. It will be available to K-2nd grade students during phase 1 of our return, and then available to 3rd-5th grade once phase 2 begins. Here is the link to register for after school care for COE. [YMCA Registration](#)

Q. What should my child bring to school each day?

Every student will need to wear a mask, and bring a chromebook and charger to school every day. If you charge the Chromebook at night, there is no need to send the charger. Chromebooks will be sent home every day to be prepared for a possible NTI day or quarantine.

Q. How can my family help prevent COVID exposures at school?

Each family will sign the [Family Assurance of Student Health Agreement](#) before sending their child to school. By signing this agreement each family is attesting that they will monitor their child's health each day and not send them to school if they have a temperature of 100.4° or greater or are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19. You can also help by reducing your exposure to COVID outside of the school by wearing masks and following CDC guidance.

Q. What will happen if my child or my child's class has to quarantine?

If an individual student is quarantined due to exposure, they will join the remote learning class for their grade level. If an entire class is quarantined due to exposure, they will follow the remote learning schedule and Zoom from home with their homeroom teacher. Families will be notified and instructions will be provided case by case.

Q. What will happen if there is bad weather and students can't come to school?

Please watch for district communication for inclement weather. However, in most cases we will have an NTI day. Students will remain home and follow the [remote learning schedule](#) to continue Zoom lessons with their teacher.

Q. Who is my child's remote learning teachers

Remember that students who are registered for remote learning will be assigned a new teacher and will not remain with their current homeroom. The remote learning teachers are listed below. Your child will be introduced to their remote learning teacher prior to the transition.
