

# Dress for Success ATTIRE GUIDELINES

Coventry Oak Elementary is a school of innovation and student-driven learning, where students experience success through creative, fun and challenging lessons. Our school climate will reflect this premise and our students will dress in a way that signifies a drive for social and academic success. The following is a description of acceptable attire for students attending our school.

- Shirts**
  - solid color polo shirts
  - button-down collared shirts
  - short-sleeved or long-sleeved
  - any color but no stripes, checks or plaid
  - COE t-shirts may be worn on dress down days or field trips
- Pants/Skirts**
  - khaki, blue or black chinos (pants or shorts are acceptable)
  - khaki, blue or black skirts (must wear shorts, tights or leggings underneath)
  - skirts and shorts must pass modesty test of longer than fingertips
- Dresses**
  - solid color polo dresses with collar and buttons, any color
  - must wear shorts, tights or leggings underneath
- Shoes**
  - closed-toe shoes, gym shoes, sneakers
  - no high heels, no flip-flops, no sandals
- Outerwear**
  - solid color sweaters, COE or solid sweatshirts without a hood, turtlenecks, vests, light weight jackets without a hood can be worn in the building
  - coats and hoodies are not worn in the building and are stored in classroom cubby

### Casual/Dress Down Days

Casual days are a privilege based on behavior. Casual days will occur every Friday and at Principal’s discretion. Casual days will follow FCPS guidelines (in FCPS handbook).

\*Students who are out of dress code will be changed into dress code attire provided by Coventry Oak or the student’s family.
