Your child has been referred as being a high potential learner, and has been selected by their school as a student in the Primary Talent Pool (PTP). PTP is a group of students who possess demonstrated or potential ability to perform at exceptionally high levels in the primary grade years (K-3) in the areas of mental ability, specific academic (math, language arts, social studies, and science), creativity, leadership, and visual/performing arts. The purpose of selecting students for PTP is to provide early enrichment for those students whose talents must be nurtured in order to fully develop. Together, your child's classroom teacher, GT teacher and other staff members will work together to meet the needs of your child in the area selected for PTP.

Students are selected for PTP through informal evidences collected by the classroom teacher. These evidences are then brought to the Primary Recommendation Committee. The Primary Recommendation Committee consists of primary teachers, counselors, administrators, gifted education personnel, and other appropriate personnel familiar with the child's potential or demonstrated abilities. At this meeting a decision is made if a student is selected for PTP and how the school will work together to meet their individual needs.
