2022 Seal of Biliteracy Highlights



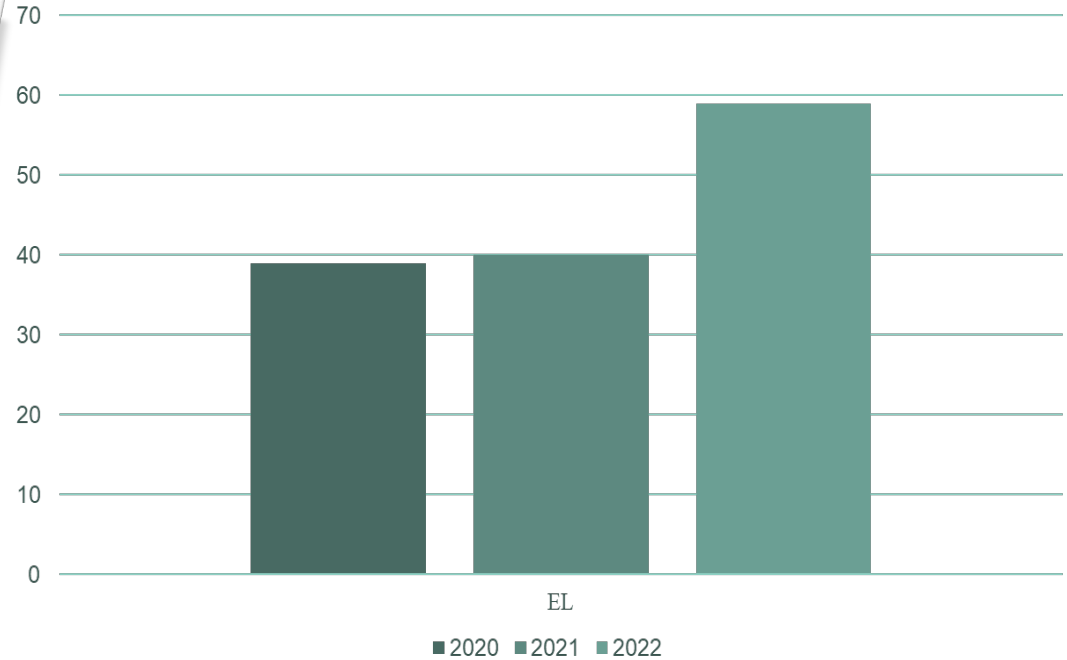
Overall, for 2022:

- 33 % of all applicants at BSHS
- 21% of all applicants at HCHS

In comparison to 2021:

- 50% increase in recipients at FDHS
- 37% increase in applicants at LHS
- 70% increase in recipients at PLD
- 111% increase in applicants at TCHS
