Students will practice proper weapon safety - utilizing the simulated firing range, practice verbal and physical skills needed to engage a threat, perform simulated traffic stops, execute initial crime scene response and investigation, practice proper evidence collection and documentation, and explore the effects of impairment with fatal vision equipment.

Students will also work on their physical aptitude by navigating our outdoor challenge (obstacle) course and other team challenges.
