Each freshman student is invited to **Freshman Orientation on Wednesday, August 8th (schedule on back)**. Bring a pen or pencil. This is a very popular event and we are anticipating a very high turnout. **All students should be completing their summer reading assignment for Freshman English. After Freshman Orientation on August 8th, parents are invited to join their child beginning at 5:30pm. Our staff will be available to meet you in the cafeteria to share information about how students can be involved in our school at our ACTIVITY EXPO. The building will be open to tour and many teachers will be in their classrooms beginning at 5:30 pm as well. If a freshman did not receive his or her schedule at registration, it will be available at 5:30 pm in the cafeteria. Students should tour the building with schedule in hand!

Forms pick-up has been streamlined for the convenience of parents. The schedule for pick-up and return is on the back of this sheet. Returning these forms and paying fees as scheduled enables teachers to start instruction on the first day. Registration will be in the gym foyer.

Please plan to pay your child's school fees during Registration. School fees are determined by the child's schedule, so they are different for every student. Generally, fees run from \$75 to \$150 depending on the actual classes a student is taking. We are not able to provide this information in advance. If needed, you can make a partial payment of at least half with the remaining payment being made before October 1st. **Students on free/reduced lunch are exempt from fees but must turn in an updated form. A new form is required each year.**

If there are blanks or extra courses, or if the student is registered for the wrong course, please contact the counseling office at 381-3481. Fayette County Board of Education Policy indicates schedules may only be changed for the following reasons:

- (a) A level change to a higher level class
- (b) Failure to meet prerequisites
- (c) Computer error.

Students who have signed up for an AP course may NOT change their schedule.
