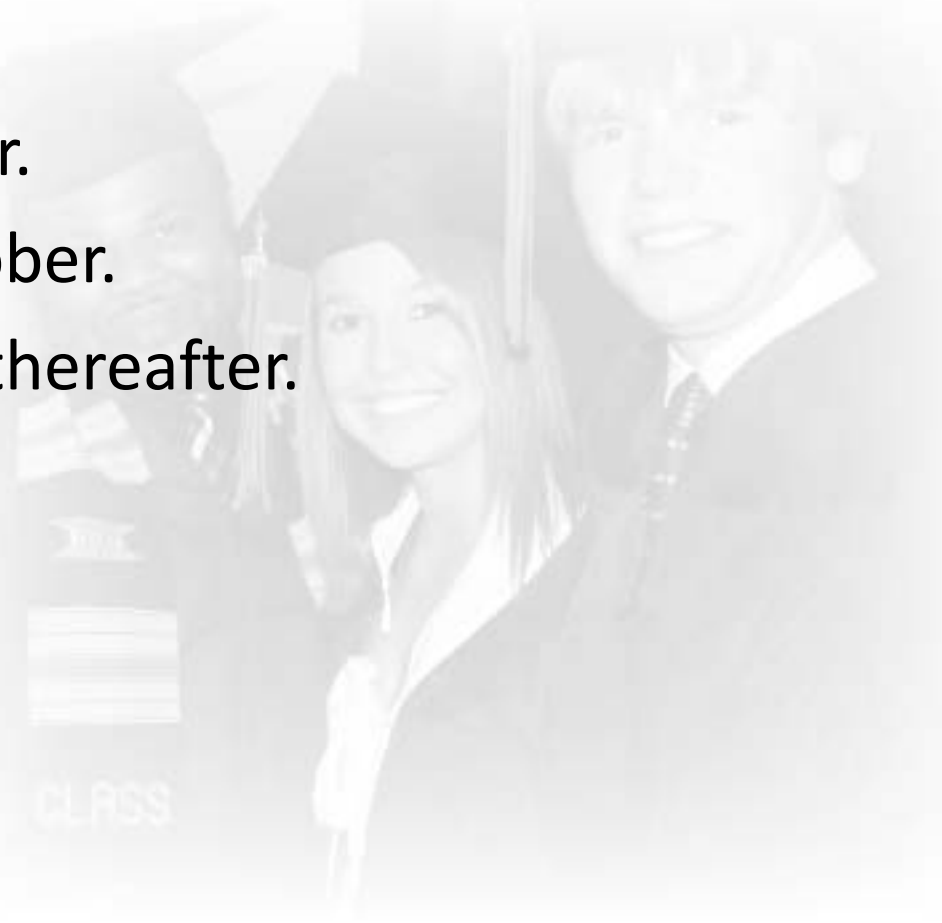
- E.C. Matthews Company, Inc. is finalizing a schedule of start and stop dates that will be communicated to the schools.
