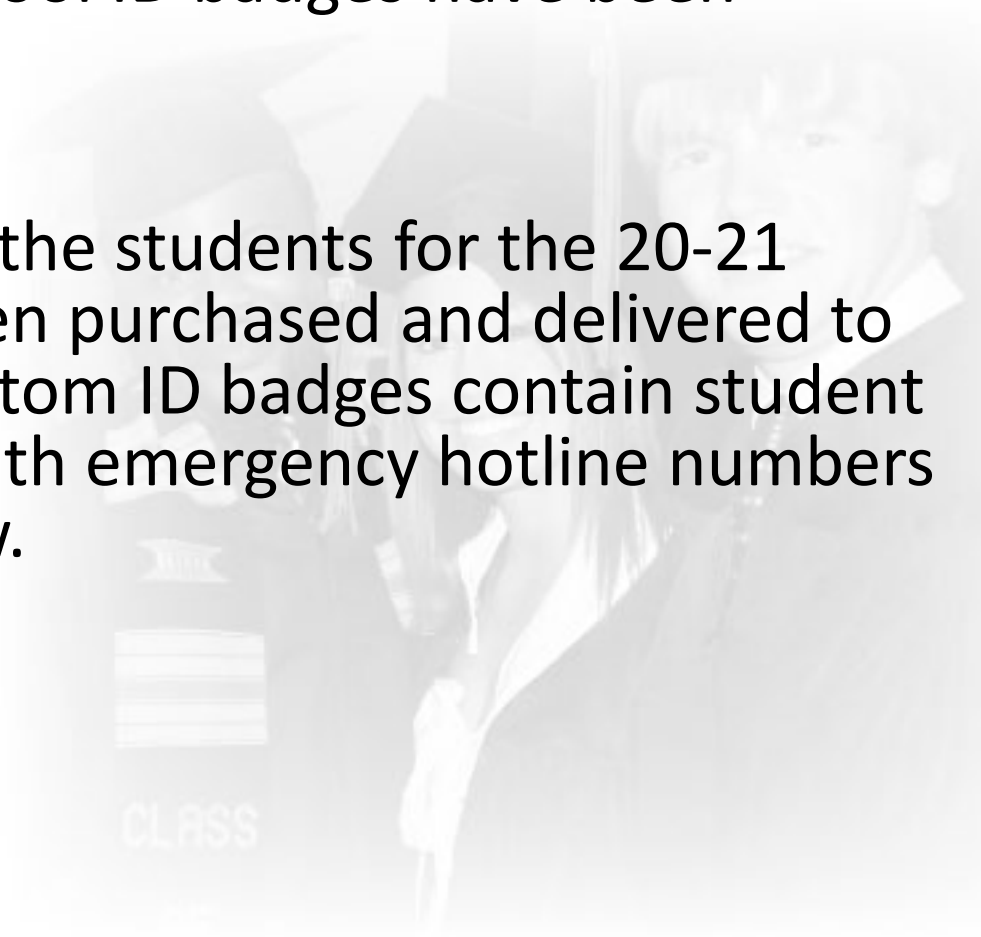

Student & Staff IDs and Raptor - Visitor Management System



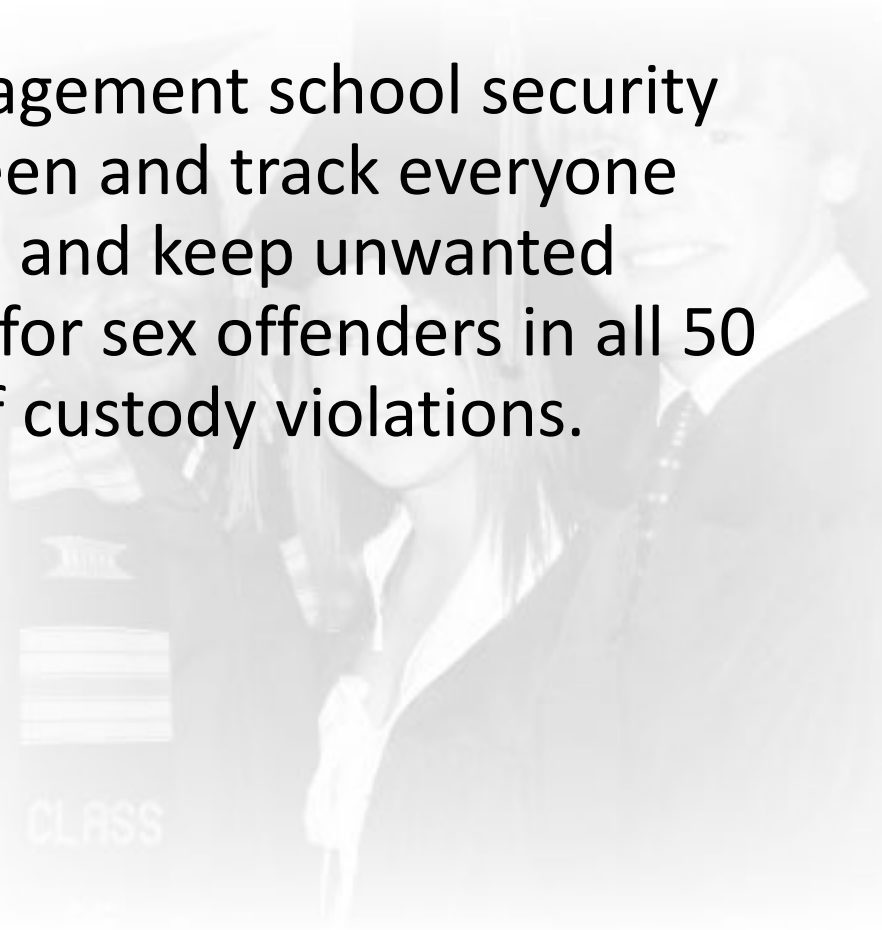
- Middle and High School ID badges have been implemented.
- Custom lanyards for the students for the 20-21 school year have been purchased and delivered to each school. The custom ID badges contain student information along with emergency hotline numbers required by state law.



Upgraded Emergency Communication Systems



- The Raptor Visitor Management school security system allows us to screen and track everyone coming into our schools and keep unwanted entrants out. It screens for sex offenders in all 50 states and alerts staff of custody violations.

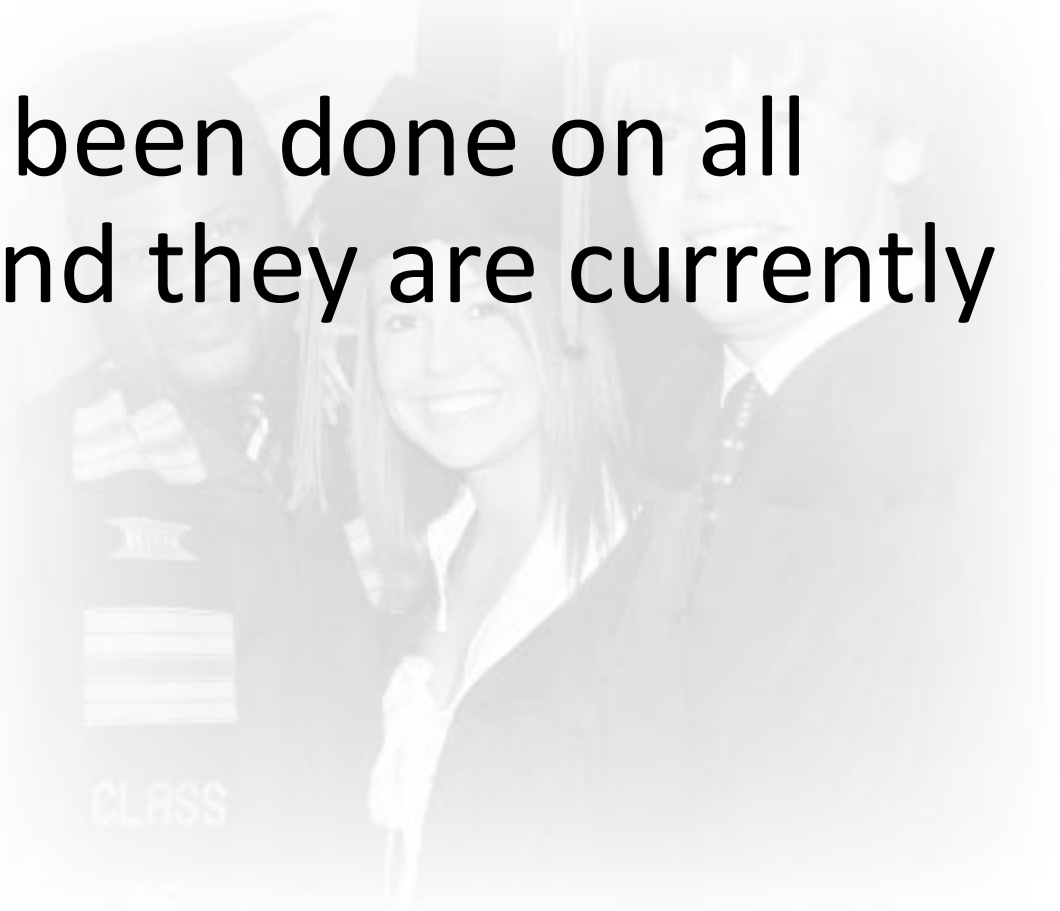

Metal Detectors and Security Ambassadors



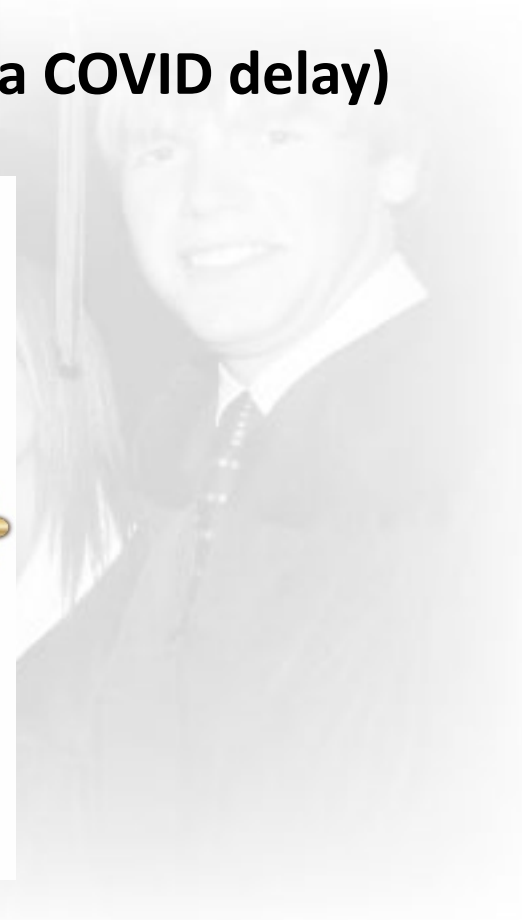
Maintenance has been done on all metal detectors and they are currently available for use.

As of January 8, 2020

There are a total of 50 District Mental Health Specialists serving students across the district; 39 at elementary schools, 4 serving middle schools, and 6 serving high schools, 1 itinerant. DMHS continue to participate in PLC's working on trauma informed care; tier one prevention; equity, diversity and restorative practices.

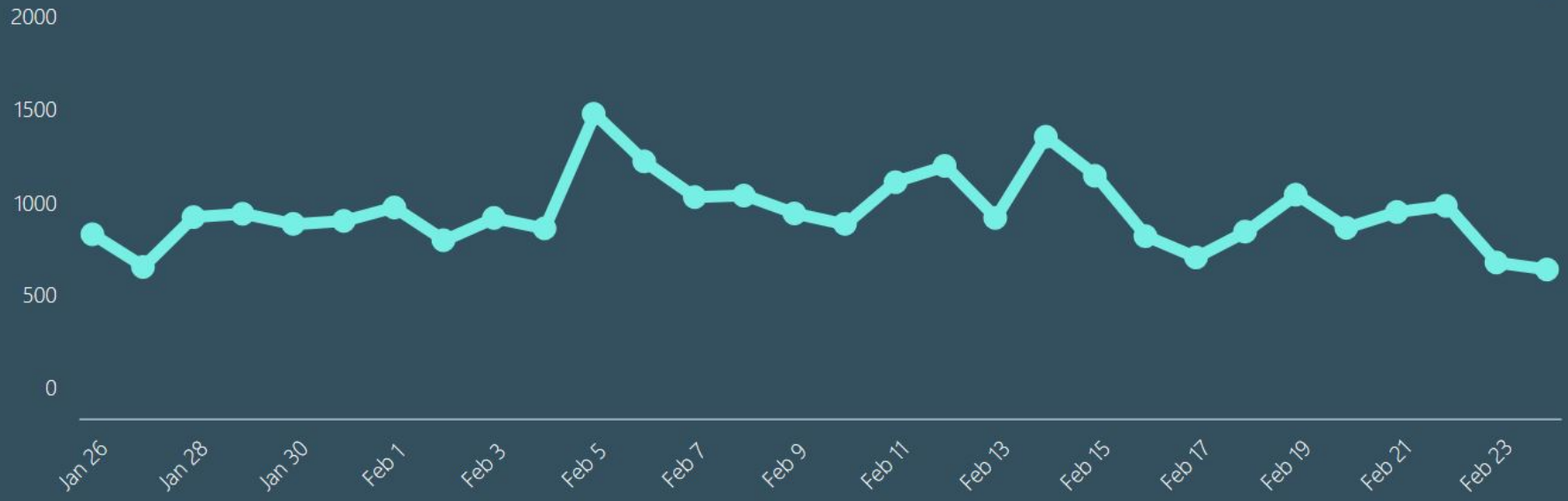
