- Lanyards will represent each school and all id badge materials will come through the office of the Associate Director of Safety and Security.

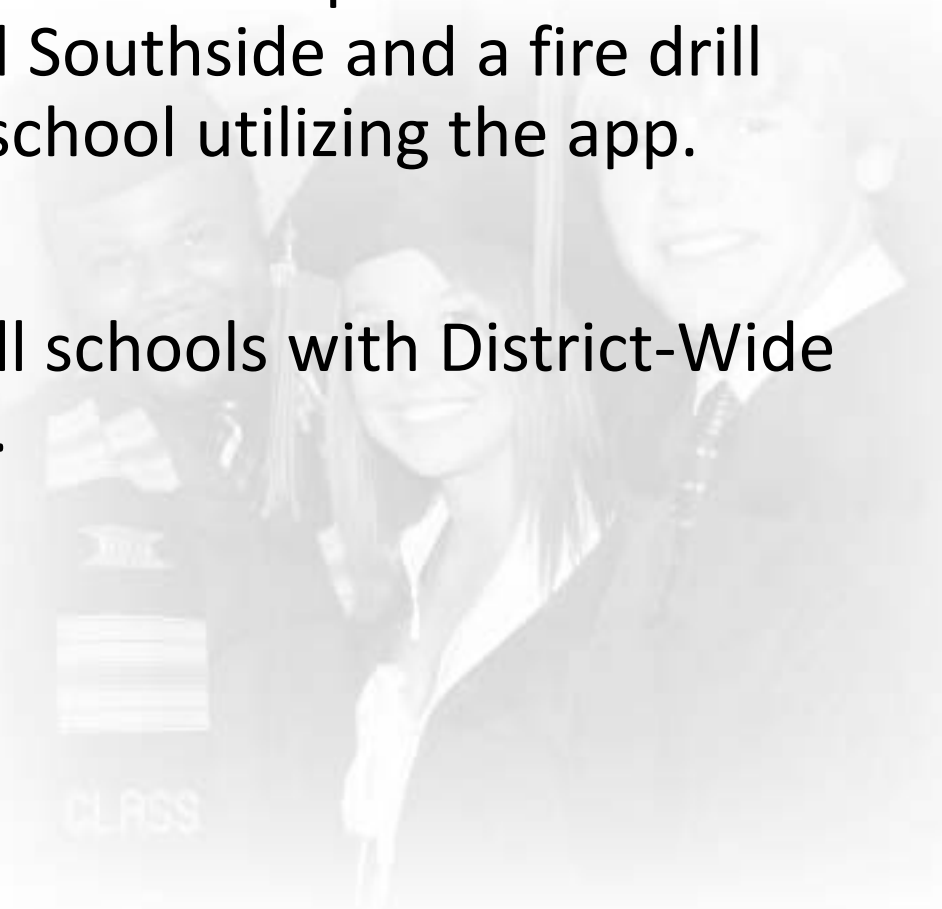

# Upgraded Emergency Communication Systems



The Crisis Go platform has been implemented at Picadome, Lafayette and Southside and a fire drill was completed at each school utilizing the app.

# Secure Vestibules



- The capital construction process required by KDE was followed and no bids were received.
- We entered into Noncompetitive Negotiations and two contractors submitted proposals on May 29, 2019.
- The lowest and best bid was from E.C. Matthews Company, Inc. for all three groups of vestibules.
- Construction at some of buildings will start in October 2019 and all 28 vestibules are to be completed by December 2020.
- A schedule of start and stop dates for construction is being provided by the contractor for clear communications and coordination with schools.
