Sandersville Elementary Tier 1 Acknowledgement System

PURPOSE:

The purpose of implementing a whole class acknowledgement system is to encourage students to work together as a group to minimize undesirable behaviors. When problem behavior occurs, the teacher typically spends precious instructional time in order to correct it. Offering students an incentive to self-correct undesirable behavior and increase their use of socially appropriate behavior, should allow teacher and students to regain instructional time. In addition, students will be taught to self-monitor and correct their own behavior, which are critical life skills. Finally, it will help to develop a sense of class of community and teamwork.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. During the school day, <u>all faculty and</u>
 <u>staff</u> will have an opportunity to
 recognize classes following our
 Guidelines for Success (*Self Sufficient*, *Hard Working*, *A+ Attitude*, *Respectful*, *Kindness*, and *Successful*).
- 2. When a class demonstrates our school-wide expectations as a group, the faculty/staff member who recognizes the behavior will announce this to the class and teacher. The faculty/staff member will let the homeroom teacher know he/she can add a Shark Smile to their class chart which is posted outside each homeroom door. Homeroom teachers will not give out Shark Smiles and recognitions to their own class.
- 3. Once a class accumulates a certain number of Shark Smile stickers, they may redeem them for a reward. The school PBIS team designed a reward tower to encourage positive behavior among whole classes in common areas and throughout the daily routine.
- 4. The homeroom teacher will email Ms. Williams once they have received the number of Shark Smiles to obtain a reward and she will help manage the reward if needed and give the class a new chart to collect more Shark Smiles.
- 5. Classes will receive the reward within3 days of earning it.
