Dear Sandersville Families,

As of last week's FCPS Board Meeting, it was shared that the district is **hoping** to have all students return to school on **November 2 using the Hybrid Model**. This means half of our students would attend school Monday and Tuesday while the other half attend Thursday and Friday. When that decision has been finalized by the Board of Education, and **Sandersville's Hybrid Model Plan** has been approved at the district level, I will send additional information to all families about how that will be implemented.

Students should complete **Literacy and Language** each day, for reading support. Students will also complete **Imagine Math** each day.
