## Principal's Message

Dear Sandersville Families,

With COVID 19 cases on the rise, we are working closely with the **FCPS Health Services Coordinator, Debbie Boian, and the Lexington Health Department.** While guidance can change, sometimes daily, we will continue to make **student, staff, and family health the top priority.**

While the CDC has reduced isolation and quarantine time to 5 days for certain individuals, The Lexington Health Department and FCPS are still following the **Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services** and requiring a **10 day quarantine for students, at this time.** Any unvaccinated student exposed to a positive case at school will be offered Test to Stay or can complete the 10 day quarantine. These students will have the option of a Day 8 return with a negative test from Day 5 through Day 7. **Vaccinated students will not need to participate as long as they are symptom free.**

We appreciate your patience and support as we navigate these changes together.
