KVC BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

AGENCY DESCRIPTION: KVC provides basic foster care as well as specialized foster care including Therapeutic Foster Care and Respite Care.

Therapeutic Foster Care provides services to children that have been abused, neglected or have experienced serious traumatic events. These children often have difficulty regulating their emotions and may present challenging behaviors. These children have often had multiple placements and need extra support in making a successful transition to foster care and ultimately a transition into a permanent placement.

Respite Care provides services to children who are currently placed in another KVC foster home but need a temporary placement. This service is designed for foster parents to help each other when circumstances in their home temporarily make it difficult to give the child the care that they need.

NECCO

AGENCY DESCRIPTION: Most NECCO locations are certified for foster care and adoption, including Foster2Adopt program. Participants will need to attend an orientation session, either in their own home or in the office, where NECCO personnel will answer questions and discuss the path to adoption. Adoptions through foster care are often funded by the state and in most cases, there are few or no fees. Federal or State programs offer assistance to remove the barriers that may prevent a family from adopting through foster care. Adoption assistance can include medical assistance and monthly maintenance payments. NECCO provides services even after the child has been adopted. NECCO provides services 24-hour, 7 days a week need-based care to the foster parents and the child.

SUNRISE CHILDREN SERVICES

AGENCY DESCRIPTION: Sunrise Foster Care services are throughout the state of Kentucky. They have been serving orphans since 1869. Sunrise offers a Therapeutic Family Foster Care program. The foster care parents are specially trained to care for children with more medical or behavioral needs. Examples include children who have medical needs such as diabetes, epilepsy, or physical impairments; or children who are developmentally delayed, or who have emotional or behavioral disorders, often as a result of gross abuse or neglect. This includes symptoms resulting from prenatal exposure to drugs and alcohol. ADHD, attachment disorders or other mental health concerns. Some children are considered hard to place because they are a teenager, or they are from a large sibling group that needs to stay together. The goal of Sunrise Foster Care is Foster – To – Adopt.

AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

BIG BROTHERS/BIG SISTERS OF THE BLUEGRASS

AGENCY DESCRIPTION: The BBBS of the Bluegrass provides professionally supported mentorship to children and families. They serve children ages 6 – 13 throughout Central Kentucky and connect them with positive adult professionals and volunteers in their communities. They offer community-based programs, school-based programs, workplace programs and a “bigs in blue” programs where youth can be paired up with local law enforcement as their positive mentor.

Community-based mentoring pairs Bigs and Littles and involves one-on-one outings and activities doing things the Bigs and Littles can do together like: taking a walk in the park, going to a museum, attending one of the BBBS events, listening to music, hanging out and talking. Some Bigs meet with their Littles one hour each week, some Bigs meet their Littles on the weekends, some Bigs meet their Littles for a few hours once a month. Each pairing is unique to the pairing.

School-based mentoring takes place in the school and is teacher approved. Bigs and Littles work on homework, the school day or shoot hoops. Fayette County schools involved: William Wells Brown, Booker T. Washington, Breckinridge Elementary, Tates Creek Elementary, Mill Creek Elementary.

City Mentors allows Littles to pair up with successful, professional Bigs and get one-on-one mentorship with them in their workplace. City Mentors was started in 2017 as a connection with Lexington Fayette Urban County Government and has so far been very successful .

Bigs in Blue is a one-on-one program that connects youth with the law enforcement in their communities to build long-lasting, trustworthy relationships.

LFUCG – PARKS & RECREATION ESP & REAL PROGRAM

AGENCY DESCRIPTION: The Extended School Program and the Recreation Enrichment and Learning Program offer affordable, high-quality child care. Students must reapply every year. The ESP is currently offered at Athens-Chilesburg, Garrett Morgan, Julius Marks, Maxwell, Northern, Stonewall and Mary Todd, Yates and the Academy at Tates Creek. Staff plan daily activities for students and coordinate curriculum with each school's principals and teachers. Activities include homework assistance along with recreation and leisure activities. In the event of a snow day, ESP will offer the option to attend Maxwell, Stonewall and Athens Chilesburg from 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM, weather permitting. Students using the snow day program will be charged a \$10 fee to their weekly tuition. Parents will need to provide children with a sack lunch on snow days. The REAL Program is a gully-licensed after-school program for middle-school students. It is currently offered at Edith J. Hayes and Jessie Clark. REAL is not open on snow days. There is a \$20 registration fee due with each child's application, for every new school year. There is a maximum registration fee per family of \$40. Any child picked up after 6:00 PM will have a late charge of \$5, and an additional \$5 will be charge for every 5 minutes the child is not picked up. If the child is not picked up by 6:30 PM, the LPD will be notified.

Many of the boys come from backgrounds involving alcohol and substance abuse, and counseling is available for those issues as well. The program can accommodate more than 50 boys, housing them in five residential cabins, where they enjoy activities such as camping, backpacking, canoeing, a high rope course, a climbing tower and zip lines.

Spring Meadows Treatment Center serves up to 20 severely abused boys ages 12 – 18. The boys receive individual, group and family therapy, along with drug and alcohol counseling for those that need it. The facility provides housing, meals, education and recreational space, along with outdoor areas.

Glen Dale provides therapeutic and individual support for girls ages 12 – 18. Most of the girls arrive with a history of abuse or neglect which has led to behavioral and emotional problems. Through individual, group and family therapy, trauma recovery support, individual life skills, and substance abuse counseling, we help to promote healing.

Woodlawn is a Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facility located on the Woodlawn Campus in Danville. It provides round-the-clock services to boys ages 6 – 18 with severe emotional and behavioral problems. The youth require long-term, comprehensive care, but do not need hospitalization. In this setting, the boys can continue their education while benefitting from psychiatric and nursing services, as well as individual, family and group therapy, spiritual and moral growth opportunities, and recreational, educational and cultural programs. THE RIDGE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SYSTEM

AGENCY DESCRIPTION: The Ridge is accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations and houses 110 beds, providing psychiatric, mental health, substance abuse disorder services to children, adolescences, adults and older adults. Inpatient care is provided on a 24-hour basis,

seven days a week. Outpatient and partial hospitalization services are provided on a five-day per week basis, days and evenings.

Child Inpatient Acute Services treatment program is for children ages 5 – 11 years old who are experiencing symptoms of psychiatric illness. These children are overwhelmed due to underlying trauma or abuse and can benefit from a positive, supportive and stable environment to help them recover. The program includes a trauma-informed case approach, an evidence-based model for working effectively with trauma survivors. The Ridge also incorporates elements of Collaborative Problem Solving (CPS), which is another evidenced-based model for working effectively with children who demonstrate aggressive and/or out-of-control behavior, and also utilize elements of positive reinforcement. These methods help focus on positively reinforcing or rewarding appropriate or positive behavior. Children in this program are enrolled in Fayette County Public Schools and will receive one-on-one instruction from Certified Teachers in collaboration with their home community school.

Child Psychiatric Partial Hospitalization Program offers treatment to children ages 5 – 11 who are challenged managing activities at school and home. The children have emotional, behavioral or psychiatric difficulties and will likely benefit from this program. The goal is to improve the child's level of functioning while maintaining important family and community connections. This program uses elements of trauma-informed care and collaborative problem-solving in a nurturing environment that focuses on eliminating negative behaviors by increasing positive behaviors. Daily group therapy, including education and psychotherapy, and social skills training will likely cultivate the child's ability to form rewarding relationships with others. The program is Monday – Friday for four hours a day. The program is typically two to four weeks.

AGENCY DESCRIPTION: The Child and Family Wellness Center at New Vista offers numerous programs to help assist in the growth of children and their families. Programs include the First Steps Program, Access Program, Family Home Provider, Hazelwood Residential Facility and Oakwood Residential Facility.

First Steps offers services to children ages birth to age 3 and their families who have a developmental delay or a medical condition known to cause a delay. Staff provide screening and determine eligibility for services as well as coordinate services for families. Services are provided in the child's natural environment either at home, daycare, or in the community. Service professionals include: Speech Therapist, Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapist, Developmental Interventionist, Behavior Interventionist, Nutritionist, Deaf and Hard of Hearing Teacher, Visually Impaired Teacher, Psychologist and Audiology.

Access Program offers services to individuals age 3 to adults with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (IDD). Services include: Supports for Community Living (SCL) which is a Medicaid waiver designed to meet the individual needs of the person with IDD who live in community alternatives to institutional care.

Michelle P. Waiver (MPW), also a Medicaid waiver, aimed at meeting the needs of children and adults with IDD. MPW allows individuals to remain in their homes with support and services. Participants have an individualized service plan which is developed in conjunction with a case manager as well as other community providers and natural support systems.

Pre-Admission Screening and Resident Review (PASSR) provides specialized services beyond the normal scope of a nursing facility. The goal is to provide a person-centered approach to developing a plan to make an individual's life more meaningful while residing in a nursing facility.

Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) provides services and supports to adults with acquired brain injuries who are working to re-enter community life.

Participant Directed Services (PDS) provide support to recipients of the SCL, MPW, ABI and ABI-LTC waivers who choose to direct their own services. Support brokers assist an individual and/or their representative to design a budget of supports used to recruit, employ and train staff chosen by the individual and/or representative.

State General finds Services meet the individual needs of children and adults who have IDD and are not currently recipients of a Medicaid waiver like SCL or MPW. Services include case management, community living supports, and personal assistance.

Family Home Provider model a positive living situation for individuals with ISS. Individuals with IDD have a private bedroom to call their own and shares a communal living spaces with the FHP and family members.

Hazelwood Residential Facility is an Intermediate Care Facility (ICF). It is located in Louisville, Kentucky, and includes three community ICF homes: Del Maria, Windsong, and Meadows. Staff provide 24/7 care to residents. Residents participate in more than 11 enrichment classes offered during the day and are active

in a community baseball league, faith groups and a variety of Special Olympic events. Residents have employment and volunteer opportunities both on and off campus.

Oakwood Residential Facility is an ICF located in Somerset, Kentucky, offering 24/7 care to it's patients. It's mission is to assist individuals in developing skills and interests to reach personal goals and live meaningful and balanced lives. Residents participate in more than 30 enrichment classes offered during the day, are active in a community bowling league, take part in a variety of Special Olympic events with both indoor pool and gymnasium on campus.
