- Private, not-for-profit behavioral health hospital in Louisville, Kentucky.
- The hospital was originally founded in 1951 by the Sisters of Charity of Nazareth and is currently operating 220 beds.
- We continue to offer mobile Level-of-Care Assessments to all Fayette County Schools.
- We treat children, adolescents, and adults that are struggling with behavioral health and/or substance use. We also serve children with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
- If a child, adolescent, or adult meets inpatient hospitalization criteria, we have a contract with an ambulance company that will transport the patient to Louisville for treatment.
- 3 outdoor playgrounds, 2 indoor gymnasiums, fun zone, patient library, sensory room, outdoor basketball court, and a horse stable (Our occupational therapist offers hippotherapy and equine-assisted therapy to our children and adolescents with intellectual and developmental disabilities)
