



FDHS Guidance Dept. The Three E's: Determine Your Path

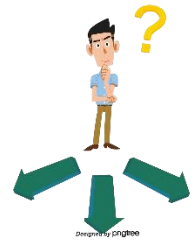
1. THE THREE E'S: ENROLLMENT, ENLISTMENT AND EMPLOYMENT

Each student's journey after high school will differ. After proper preparation students will decide to pursue one of the three E's. They will **enroll** in a postsecondary institution (2 yr. or 4 yr. college/university, trade school or apprenticeship program), **enlist** in the military or seek **employment** in the workforce.

2. RESEARCH AND EXPLORE

In order to make an informed decision regarding your college and/or career path, you must research and explore your options. Take advantage of opportunities that allow you to learn, provide exposure and experience in your area of interest.

- Freshman Seminar & Career Expo
- Participate in a college/career fair and college tour
- Register to meet with employers, college admission and military representatives who visit FDHS
- Complete a Career Assessment
- Participate in a co-op, internship, job shadowing, summer programs and volunteer
- Schedule informational interviews and research your prospective postsecondary institution, military branch, or employer
