Description

AP Art Studio is a rigorous art course where students will develop a series of artworks, engage in teacher-to-student AND student-to-student critiques. The goal of AP Art Studio is to provide a space for students to develop their skills, passion, and concepts while developing a portfolio for review by the AP Board.

The projects completed from the summer homework will potentially go towards the student's portfolio which will be submitted in the spring for AP scoring. You have a choice of three different portfolios to submit to AP: **Two dimensional media (2D), Three-dimensional media (3D), and Drawing.**

Two-dimensional Media (2D)	Three-dimensional Media (3D)	Drawing
Includes but is not limited to all painting media, drawing media, mixed media, computer generated art, flat collage, and photography.	Includes but is not limited to found objects, cardboard, ceramics, metal, plaster, and wood.	Includes but is not limited to graphite, pastel, charcoal, colored pencil, marker, and pen & ink.

Project 1

Traditional Self Portrait: The goal of the traditional self-portrait is to showcase your technical skill.

Project 2

Non-traditional Self Portrait: The goal of this assignment is to showcase your imagination and how you communicate your concepts.

Students will engage in a group critique of their summer homework during the first days of class. Come prepared with your work and ready to discuss your: use of material(s), concept development, and process in developing/making your work.

Students are strongly encouraged to look for inspiration but MUST create original work. If working from a photo reference, the photo must be non-copyright OR the student's original photograph. Students may not directly copy any existing imagery or artwork.
