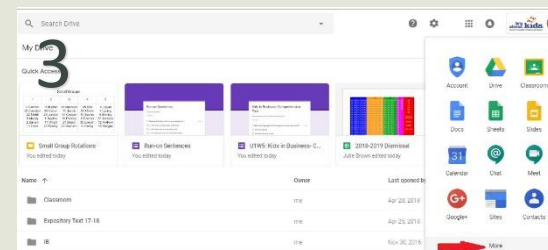
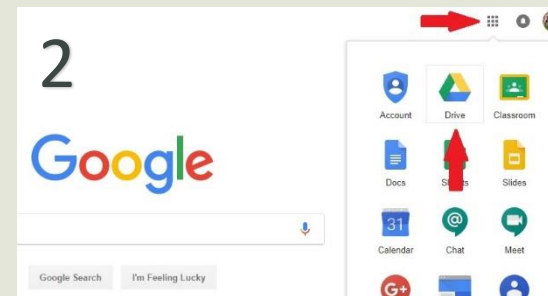
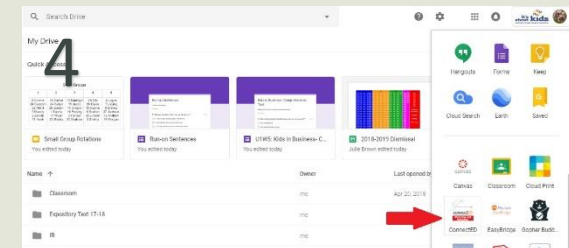
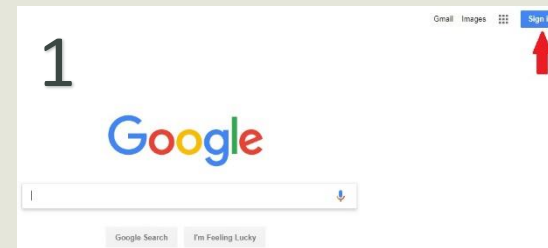
Fourth Grade Handbook

 5. Select the Wonders Grade 4 Student Edition

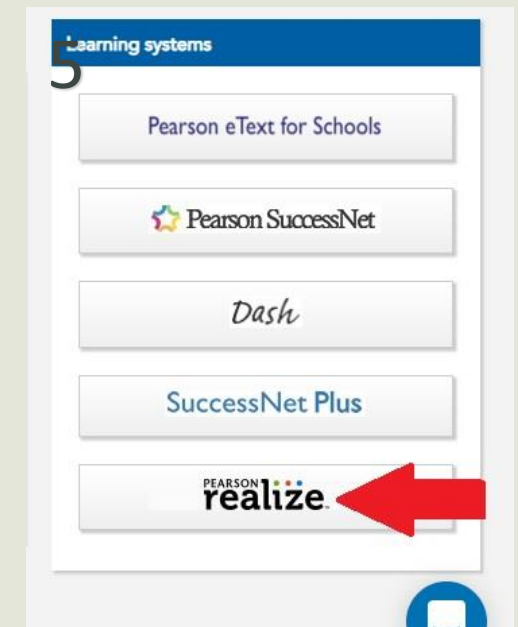
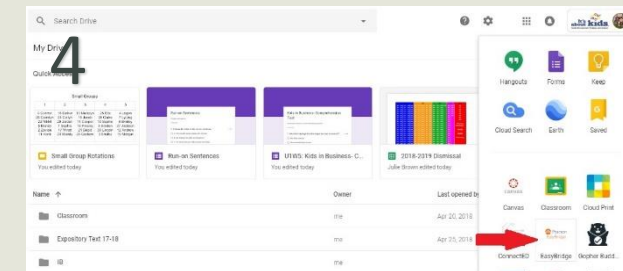
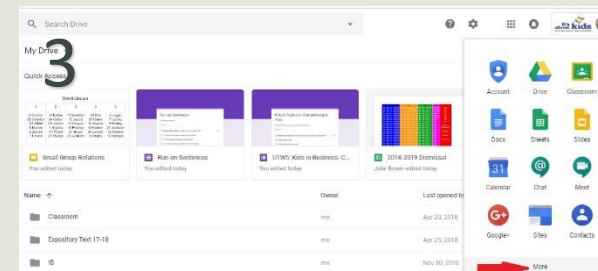
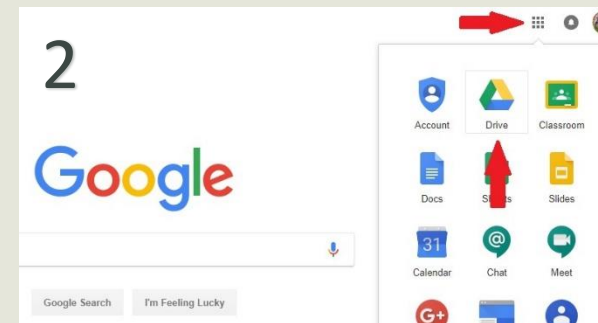
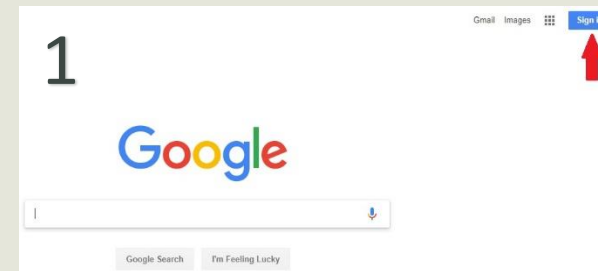


Wonders (Continued)

enVision Mathematics

- We will utilize the district provided math program, enVision Mathematics, to teach math, but will supplement as needed.
- To access enVision Mathematics online, students should complete the following steps:
 1. Sign in to Google

 3. Once in their drive, click on the “waffle” and select more
 4. Click on EasyBridge
 5. Click on Pearson Realize

Some class/home work is done as practice and will be discussed whole group or with a partner. Students will have one opportunity to correct or redo work scoring below an 80% to receive the passing score of 80%.
