

Student ID Badges and Metal Detectors

Student ID Badges

- A. Students are required to wear their own personal ID badge upon entrance to The Academies of Bryan Station High School. No entrance into the building will be permitted without their own, official student ID badge.
- B. The ID badge must be on a lanyard worn around the neck and must remain on at all times during the school day
- C. Each school year, students will be provided with one lanyard, one ID badge, and one ID badge holder.
- D. Students are permitted to return the school provided lanyard and purchase their own to wear.
- E. Should a student misplace their lanyard and/or ID badge, they may purchase another one for a fine of \$1.00 at our student ID station, **located in the wellness center**. If a student does not have the funds that day to purchase an ID badge, they will be escorted into the building by an administrator and placed in SAFE all day, and each day thereafter, until a new badge can be purchased.
- F. If a student finds their misplaced badge, they may return it to the ID station for a refund.
- G. Consequences for students who are found without an ID badge on during the school day are as follows:
 - a. First offense: issued a warning and asked to put their ID badge on.
 - b. Second offense: discipline referral (school level consequence) and phone call home
 - c. Third offense: discipline referral (school level consequence) and parent/student conference with academy principal
- G. Students are not permitted to open outside doors, for any reason, to allow someone to enter the building. **Failure to comply with this superintendent mandated procedure will result in a parent conference and out of school suspension.**

Food Deliveries

- A. Food is only allowed to be delivered by a parent/guardian or someone on the students pick-up list, which is in Infinite Campus.
- B. Food deliveries must be dropped off through the front doors (the doors by the flagpole).

Student ID Badges and Metal Detectors

Metal Detectors

- A. Student ID badge must be visible around neck before entrance to the building is permitted.
- B. Line up as directed at the doors to the 500 hallway, or at the entrance by the flagpole.
- C. While in line, student must unzip all zippers on their bags and empty all pockets into bags (for example: phones, keys, and other electronics)
- D. Step forward as directed by a safety ambassador or FCPS staff person.
- E. Walk through detector when directed to do so.
- F. If cleared proceed to appropriate AM waiting area.
- G. If not cleared, you will be directed to the wand station.
- H. If contraband is found on a student, the item/s will be placed in a freezer bag and the student will be sent on to class until an administrator is available to address the contraband. These items can include, but are not limited to: e-cigarette, vape, juul pods or tobacco products of any kind, lighters, medication that has not been logged in with our school nurse, which includes ANY over the counter medication, pepper spray, etc.

*** Failure to comply with these procedures will result in immediate administrative action ***

Entry into the building

- A. Parents/guardians, family members, community members and substitute teachers will be required to enter the building through the front doors (the door by the flagpole). Upon entry into the building, they will pass through a metal detector and if they have a bag, it will be searched for dangerous instruments.
- B. If a student opens a door, for any reason, to allow someone to enter the building without passing through the metal detectors, they will be breaking school safety protocols and will be given a school consequence in accordance with the FCPS Student Code of Conduct.
- C. Parents and community members MUST have a photo ID, sign-in, and wear a visitor pass while inside Bryan Station.
- D. Any student that leaves campus for any reason or leaves the building unsupervised, must re-enter the building and pass through the metal detectors.
