As many of you are already aware, Superintendent Manny Caulk convened the FCPS District Safety Advisory Council last school year to review and make recommendations regarding school safety. The council was comprised of students, parents, school and district employees, law enforcement representatives, city officials and community members selected for their personal experience and professional expertise in the area of safety and emergency management. Their work was informed by national, state and local experts in the areas of school safety, juvenile justice, mental health and social media, and bolstered by public input from hundreds of concerned citizens.

I am writing you to let you know about two #defendingstation Family and Community Safety Forums we are scheduling to discuss school safety recommendations and metal detector implementation for Bryan Station starting in the spring semester. At these parent forums we will do the following:

- Review the new badge protocols for all staff and students
- Review the new metal detector protocol for staff, students, parents, and community members
- Answer any questions parents, students, or community members have regarding these protocols or safety initiatives

The first #defendingstation Family and Community Safety Forum will take place **on Tuesday, November 13<sup>th</sup>** starting at 5:30 p.m. in the auditorium.

The second #defendingstation Family and Community Safety Forum will take place on **Monday, December 10<sup>th</sup>** at 5:30 p.m. in the auditorium.

We will be discussing these safety initiatives more thoroughly with students so that they are prepared when they return to school after winter break. The meetings with students will take place in late November and December by academy.

School safety is my number one priority as principal of The Academies of Bryan Station, and I look forward to speaking with each of you on one of these two dates.
