What is the Success Academy?

This program is designed to support, re-engage, and accelerate FCPS students who are over-age and under-credited in earning a high school diploma and to successfully transition them to college and/or the workforce.

Where is the Success Academy located?

The program is housed in a temporary location due to renovation of our permanent building. We are now located at 2420 Spurr Road.

Application Process



Who is Eligible for the Program?

- ▶ Students who are 16 yrs old or older, one or more grade levels behind their peers. They have repeated a year or more of high school course work
- ▶ Have low academic performance; a GPA of 2.0 or below on a 4.0 scale
- ▶ A past record of excessive absences as verified by school officials
- ▶ Has been suspended, expelled, or placed on probation during high school
- ▶ First generation high school graduate
- ▶ Has dependent children in the home
- ▶ Exhibits characteristics of lacking in motivation, direction, and/or has demonstrated a pattern of not following through with plans and goals

When is the application deadline?

- ▶ The Success Academy operates a continuous admission process and accepts students into the program throughout the school year. If the program roster is at capacity, students are placed on a waiting list in the order of intake.

How often are applications reviewed?

- ▶ Applications must be received by 7pm on the 2nd Friday of each month to be considered for enrollment during the current month's review team meeting.
- ▶ Transition Specialist contacts the applicant's counselor at the home school to request MTSS intervention info. & to schedule a date for a student observation. Observations will be held during the 4th week of each month.

Program Information



What are the hours of operation?

- ▶ The hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., which accommodate a nontraditional yet personalized pathway to ensure students graduate and transition with skills to succeed in the classroom, workforce, and community. Individual students' schedules will vary.

Is transportation provided?

- ▶ Yes, additional information is provided once a student is accepted.

What curriculum model is use?

- ▶ A Blended Learning Model (i5Curriculum) is implemented. Highly qualified teachers facilitate instructional delivery with digital curriculum and provide teacher-directed individual, whole, or small group instruction and remediation. In addition we participate in community outreach programs as well as Project Based Learning.
