# Contact Tracing & Quarantine process

- School staff will use seating charts to contact trace and identify students who sat within 6 feet of the positive case in the cafe and within 3 feet of the positive case in the classroom. School staff will also make a list of AM and PM transportation contacts if the student rides the bus or carpools, and a list of any sports/clubs.
- School staff will call parent/guardian of all students on the contact tracing list to notify them that they need to pick up their student as soon as possible to quarantine at home.

# Contact Tracing & Quarantine process

- School staff will review the following with parent/guardian:
  - How students will access work during quarantine
  - When the student may return to school (on day 8 after a negative COVID test on day 5, 6, or 7 and no symptoms; or on day 11).
  - During quarantine, students are not required to get tested, but are encouraged if they have symptoms.
  - If a student is vaccinated, they are not required to quarantine, but may do so by choice, and should monitor for symptoms.
- School staff will call the student's classroom and ask that the student report to the quarantine location (usually the cafe or student center).

# Contact Tracing & Quarantine process

- Students will wait in the quarantine location until someone is able to pick them up.
- Being required to quarantine does not mean that you have COVID, but that you need to quarantine in case you do, in order to prevent the spread.
- While you are on quarantine, you are required to complete all classwork for every class. Classwork can be accessed on CANVAS. Your teachers are posting links to work and video tutorials so you can stay on track. If you have questions about an assignment, please email your teacher. All tests and MAP assessments will be taken when you return to school.

What if I'm at school and have symptoms of COVID?

# COVID testing at school

- If you have symptoms (fever, headache, fatigue, cough, body aches, loss of taste/smell, sore throat, runny nose, nausea), with parent permission, the school has access to rapid tests and can test you at school.
- Or, you need to call home and have a parent/guardian pick you up to get tested at a testing facility.

# I'm Positive & Quarantine process

- Your results will be reported to the health department.
- The health department will contact your parent/guardian every day to get updates on your symptoms and will give you a release date for when your quarantine has ended.
- Your parent/guardian should also call the school to notify us so we can contact trace and quarantine other students you were in contact with.
- If you are feeling able, you should continue to access, complete and turn in working for all classes using CANVAS.

What if someone in my household tests positive for COVID?

# Close Contact Positive & Quarantine process

- If someone in your home tests positive, you will also be required to quarantine.
- Their results will be reported to the health department.
- The health department will contact your household every day to get updates on symptoms and will give your household a release date for when the quarantine has ended. Your quarantine may be longer if you are unable to COMPLETELY quarantine away from the positive case.

# Close Contact Positive & Quarantine process

- Your parent/guardian should also call the school to notify us so we know why you are at home.
- No other students at school who you were in contact with will need to quarantine, unless you test positive.
- You should continue to access, complete and turn in working for all classes using CANVAS.
