The Mission

The goal of the Anita Madden Bluegrass Boys Scholarship is to improve and enhance academic experience of socio-economically disadvantaged gifted middle school boys motivating them to pursue higher education. The Lexington School

The Lexington School is an independent day school for children ages 2 through 8th Grade. The curriculum is complete and challenging, and the culture is one of high expectation for every single student. The Anita Madden Bluegrass Boys Scholarship

This three-year scholarship will pay all expenses for a single middle school boy entering 6th grade. The scholarship covers all materials, fees, including technology and Friday dress uniforms, after school care, athletics, and school trips for the student. The student chosen to receive the scholarship will be an academically promising young man of high integrity and work ethic who has the support of an individual in his life who will partner with the school to assure his success.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Parents receive a scholarship packet
- Parents complete scholarship application and provide school with required documentation
- Parents are welcomed to visit the school and tour the campus, view the classrooms and speak with teachers, and meet with the Director of Admission to learn more about the School's philosophy and programs and discuss their child's educational needs
- Finalists are selected via two rounds of screening
 - If the student is chosen as a first round finalist, he is invited to spend an entire day visiting The Lexington School during which time he will be *interviewed and academically assessed*
 - The second round finalists and their families will be invited back for a second interview
