

SCHOOL SPACE POLICY

Stonewall Elementary School

In order to comply with KRS160.345-2(i), Stonewall Elementary School will implement the following School Space Policy.

Consideration of school space assignments shall be made based upon what is in the best interest of children, and the following criteria:

1. Federal, state, and/or local requirements and restrictions
2. Class size needs
3. Program space needs
4. Grade level or team groupings
5. Percentage of time students are in the assigned space.
6. Architecturally designed spaces

School space shall be defined as all areas of the campus, both inside and outside, at Stonewall Elementary School.

School staff may send the principal a written request at any time in regards to alternative space allocations, or who want to request change in space allocation.

The principal will consult with staff members affected by a change in space allocation as soon as possible. The principal will also consult with the Stonewall SBDM Council at the next SBDM meeting about changes in space allocation.
