### **Student Achievement (Michelle Grant, Angela Hummel)**

- a. MAP Testing- This starts next tuesday and it will run for a week- all grade levels will be MAP testing (Reading and Math)
- b. Galileo Testing- in January, we will begin Galileo testing (Reading and Math)
  - i. Both of these assessment will be taken on their chromebooks in the lab and in the GT classroom in order for a better controlled environment with lots of supports in place
  - ii. Most likely in January, we will have student achievement data to share after taking the MAP test and Galileo tests
