

Crawford Middle School Math Placement Policy

Students will be assigned to math classes based on the following criteria. With exception of the 6th grade Pre-Algebra course, students must meet two out of the three criteria to be placed in one of the advanced math courses.

6	6 th Grade Common Core	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any student who is not placed in Pre-Algebra
6		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Automatic enrollment will be given to students who score at or above the 96th percentile on one of their three previous MAP tests <p>All other students must meet the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Scored in the 85th-95th percentile on one of their three previous MAP tests OR a minimum Spring MAP score of 230 AND 80% or higher on the FCPS district math screening
7	Pre-Algebra (7 th /8 th Grade Common Core)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any student who is not placed in Algebra I
7	Algebra I (High School Algebra)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A minimum MAP score of 240 80% or higher on Pre-Algebra screening Teacher recommendation
8	Algebra Part A (8 th Grade Common Core)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any student who is not placed in Algebra I or Geometry
8	Algebra I (High School Algebra)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A minimum MAP score of 240 80% or higher on Algebra screening Teacher recommendation
8	Geometry (To be considered for Geometry, students must have passed Algebra I.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A minimum MAP score of 245 80% or higher on Algebra screening Teacher recommendation

These additional guidelines for placement apply:

- Students with no MAP data available **must** take the MAP test and/or the Crawford Math Placement Exam prior to scheduling their math class. This includes currently enrolled students and students new to Crawford Middle School.
- After evaluation by the math department a student may be reassigned to another math course within the current school year. Before student reassignment within the school year, a parent conference must be implemented to notify of reassignment.
