**POLICY**

**1. Categories of Users**

- a. Students

- a. The Kentucky Academic Standards for Technology is required for all students pursuant to 704 KAR 3:305. The Technology Standards represent knowledge and skills that should be demonstrated through the transition of each grade level.
- b. The standards will be demonstrated through performance-based competency in technology within all the curriculum areas.

**3. DESCRIPTION AND EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE USE**

- a. E-mail among students and staff within the school and other locations.
- b. Accessing remote sources of information for academic purposes.
- c. Sending and receiving electronic files for academic purposes.
- d. Uploading information to share with other individuals for academic purposes.
- e. Announcements of school events (excluding non-approved events and commercial ventures) with approval from school administration.

**4. AGREEMENT FORM TO BE SIGNED BY PARENTS AND STUDENTS/USERS**

- a. Students who have not returned the Fayette County Public School's Acceptable Use Policy permission form signed by the student and his/her parent or legal guardian will have only Basic Access when they log into a device. The Basic Access status allows the student to use all approved programs by the district which includes Google, Canvas, IC, webmail and any curriculum supported tools.
- b. Students agree to the terms of the Crawford Middle School Acceptable Use Policy.
