

# School Supply List for First Grade Spanish Immersion

\*Please have **two** school boxes “premade” ready when you bring your supplies to school. These school boxes should be a solid color, (no designs). The school boxes should contain one opened box of 24 count Crayola crayons, 1 glue stick and one pair of scissors. We will give the students the pencils to keep in their boxes at school. They will have their own personal school box for the English and Spanish classroom. This will help in controlling the transmission of germs because we won’t be sharing materials. Please write your student’s name on the bottom of each school box with a permanent marker.

- 3 packages of the big, round Elmer’s glue sticks
- 8 boxes of 24 count Crayola Crayons
- 1 box of washable Crayola Markers (10 count, classic colors)
- 1 standard size backpack (no wheels please)
- 2 pairs of Fiskars scissors
- 2 packages of black Expo dry erase markers
- 2 boxes of Kleenex tissues
- 2 regular size (plain, no designs) pencil boxes
- Clorox/Lysol wipes (any amount is appreciated)
- 2 small travel size hand sanitizers for the students to keep in their pencil boxes, please make sure these bottles are refillable. We will refill them at school when they become empty.
- 1 box of regular size band-aids
- 1 inch white binder with clear pockets on the cover and pockets on the inside
- 1 package either/both gallon size or sandwich size baggies
- 1 pair of headphones to keep at school
- 2 primary writing journals, the one that has the drawing part at the top of the page and the the writing lines at the bottom

Please plan to have your child bring the supplies with them at Open House or the first day of school. The only thing that we need prepared is both school boxes with supplies as listed above. The other items can be left in a Target/Kroger/Walmart bag. Just make sure your student's name is on the bottom of the school boxes. Thank you so much for your help and support with this matter. We are so excited for a "somewhat" normal start to the school year and seeing all of our sweet first graders!
