Items Needed	Purchased
1 box of markers – 8 count	
1 box of colored pencils – 12 count	
1 large zippered pencil pouch with three holes (large enough to hold all of the markers and colored pencils)– we recommend the Five Star three hole pencil pouch 11in x 83/4 in.	
2 composition book with regular lined paper for science/language arts	
1 composition book with graph paper for math with Sra. McCord	
1 small pair of scissors	
Case-It dual D-ring zip binder - 2 inch rings –(this can take the place of a backpack-students will travel between classes with this binder)**see note at the bottom	
2 boxes of tissue	
1 box of large dry erase markers	
Boys – 1 box of Ziploc sandwich size baggies	
Girls – 1 box of quart size Ziploc baggies	
2 boxes of pencils – 24 count (students may not bring mechanical pencils)	
1 pack pink erasers (NOT the kind that goes on top of a pencil)	
4 glue sticks and 1 bottle of liquid glue	
2 packs of post-it notes (3in x 3in)	
4 red pens	
2 packs loose leaf notebook paper	
2 containers of Clorox wipes	
1 pack of highlighters	
1 pack of 4x6 lined index cards	
1 pair of headphones or earbuds for use in computer lab and with ChromeBook	

Wish list items to turn in to teacher (not required):

Paper towels, extra Composition Books (regular lined and graph paper), extra packs of colored pencils, Band-Aids

**We recommend the Case-It D-Ring binder because of its durability. One of our students was able to keep his same Case-It binder throughout his 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade year!

The D-Ring (as opposed to a round ring) allows the students' planners to lie flat so students can write in their planner without taking the planner out of the notebook. The Case-It also has an organizing file system that helps students stay organized, and it contains a small pencil pouch. The student who used this binder usually chose not to bring a backpack to school because they could carry all of their supplies in the binder.
