## SPECIAL-CALLED MEETING MINUTES (DRAFT)

### AGENDA

1. Call to Order at 3:32PM by S. Sheets, seconded by M. Brajuha.  
Attendance: Grant Davis (principal), Ally Martin (teacher), Scott Sheets (teacher), Gayla Webb (teacher), Mandy Brajuha (parent), and Kathy Theis (secretary). Not present: Reuben Adatorwovor.
2. Day 4 Staffing Allocation Adjustment: Day 4 allocation for 100% enrollment (kindergarten-92 students, primary-262 students, 4th grade-77 students, and 5th grade-83 students) has provided an increase of one primary teacher, 0.5 kindergarten para, and 0.5 primary para. Last year council approved purchasing a few additional positions for a negative balance of \$94,206, but with Day 4 allocations and RTA grant money, the new balance is a positive \$31,516. The options provided are to purchase additional para support for either a 1.0 position (\$1,456 remaining), 0.8 position (\$6,303 remaining), or 0.6 position (\$13,516 remaining). We currently have both 0.8 and 0.6 para supports, with the 0.8 para supports providing additional time with a reading program called RISE. A. Martin asked if it would be beneficial to 0.8 para support to continue help with the intervention process? G. Webb stated that the 0.8 position includes a thirty minute lunch break and would only add one hour additional support to the school day, in years previous this option did not seem as necessary from council discussion. M. Brajuha discussed a previous discussion point from another hiring

season that a 0.6 does not provide benefits but a 0.8 position would, does this change any of the outcomes of the hiring pool? G. Davis shared that we can always begin with a 0.6 position and determine the use of the money later on (whether it is to increase support time in a position or technology needs of the school). S. Sheets shares that a 0.6 position would be fine for now and adding something later is an option. A. Martin stated that a 0.6 position for now but to reevaluate the school's needs in a few weeks to determine how to best spend the remaining money. G. Webb agreed to the 0.6 position and to reevaluate how to spend the remaining money. Motion to post a 0.6 kindergarten paraeducator position for the Day 4 allocation adjustment made by S. Sheets, seconded by A. Martin.

3. Professional development leave request: A 4th grade teacher is requesting to attend an IXL professional development in Lexington which would require a substitute teacher and \$75 registration fee. The goal is to bring back and train other classroom teachers on IXL planning and data usage to support classroom learning. Motion to approve the professional development leave request made by G. Webb, seconded by M. Brajuha.
4. Adjournment at 3:52PM, motion made by S. Sheets, seconded by A. Martin.
