### STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT/REPORT DATA

- a. Measuring Student Achievement - Winter 2022 MAP Data: Of 522 students, 514 students tested. 72.5% of students scored proficient/distinguished (above 61%ile) on MAP Math, 72.4% of students scored proficient/distinguished (above 61%ile) on MAP Reading. The projected proficiency for 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade Math is 21% distinguished, 48% proficient, 24.4% apprentice, and 5.3% novice. The projected proficiency for 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade Reading is 41.9% distinguished, 29.8% proficient, 16.2% apprentice, and 12.1% novice. The percentage of students who met their growth projection at this time for MAP Math is as follows: kindergarten: 72%, 1st grade: 67%, 2nd grade: 58%, 3rd grade: 67%, 4th grade: 64%, and 5th grade: 46%. The percentage of students who met their growth projection at this time for MAP Reading is as follows: kindergarten: 82%, 1st grade: 67%, 2nd grade: 77%, 3rd grade: 55%, 4th grade: 63%, and 5th grade: 60%.
