Instructional Practices

POLICY INTENT

This school-based decision making council policy is designed to assist with the implementation and monitoring of instructional practices for all students at Arlington Elementary School.

POLICY STATEMENTS

Instructional Practice for Arlington Elementary is defined as the strategies, techniques and activities used by instructional personnel to engage students in the learning process.

1. Teachers will implement research based “Best Practice” instruction to teach content area curriculum.
2. Teachers will collaborate weekly to:
 - Review the activities they have used
 - Look for ways to integrate subject areas across the curriculum
 - Discuss successes and challenges for students and teachers
 - Share possible solutions to challenges
 - Identify areas needing further work or support
3. After each district testing window teachers will meet with the principal, PSA, or coaches to discuss test results and interventions for students scoring below grade level in Reading and Math.

Teachers will meet with support staff to discuss progress and strategies to improve achievement for ELL students and those students who have IEPs.
