EXTRACURRICULAR PROGRAMS POLICY

CRITERIA FOR PROGRAMS

For an extracurricular program to be continued or to institute a new program, the program must:

- Contribute to the following Kentucky Learning Goals:
 - a) Becoming a self-sufficient individual.
 - b) Becoming responsible members of a family, work group, or community, including demonstrating effectiveness in community service.
- Generate and maintain student interest as well as attract students currently not involved in extracurricular or service projects.
- Encourage, enhance, and maintain equity including but not limited to a wide range of opportunities for both male and female students.
- Have a suitable adult sponsor and have appropriate adult supervision at all times.

PROGRAMS CURRENTLY OFFERED

Listed below are the extracurricular programs we currently provide (as of August 2014). Additional programs will be approved and instituted on their ability to meet the criteria listed in the first section of this policy.

SPORTS: Tennis, Girls on the Run

CLUBS: Academic Team, Archery, Girl Scouts, Robotics

STUDENT PARTICIPATION

Students will be eligible to participate in extracurricular activities if they:

- Maintain an overall GPA of 2.0.
- Were in attendance at least half the day of the activity or on Friday for weekend activities.
- Comply with rules established by the adult coach or sponsor for the activity.
- Where applicable, meet any requirements set by the appropriate sponsoring or governing organization.
- Players shall be expected to attend and participate in practices to be eligible for games. It will be up to coaches' discretion to determine eligibility due to missed games.

COACHES AND SPONSORS

Each extracurricular activity will be led by an adult coach or sponsor who meets any applicable requirements set in law, or by sponsoring or governing organizations. The coach or sponsor will be responsible for personally supervising or ensuring that all students are supervised by an adult while they are participating in an activity
