5. Student Achievement
 - a. Winter MAP Testing Results- Mr. V. discussed the winter MAP results.
 - i. Good growth in math. Our percentage below the 40th percentile has dropped since the fall. All but one grade was able to bring down the number of students who scored below the 40th percentile. Strength Areas: Geometry and Algebraic Thinking; Growth Areas: Number and Operations
 - ii. Good growth in reading. Our percentage below the 40th percentile has dropped as a school. 3rd and 4th grade had an increase in the number of students below the 40th percentile. A lot of growth in K and 5th. Strength Area: Literary Text, Growth Area: Informational Text and Vocabulary
 - b. Key Indicators for School Success – Mid – Year Progress Report - We've exceeded the student achievement goal for reading. Goal was 74.75% students scoring 40th percentile or better; at mid-year, we are at 76%. We also exceeded the student achievement goal for math. Our goal was 72.5% and at mid-year, we were at 76%. Our



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student achievement gap goal was 53.5% and we are currently sitting at 53.4. Our school-wide attendance goal for the year is to increase student attendance percentage. Our goal for the year is 96% and we are sitting at 95.5 currently.
