 - a. 2020 – 2021 Initial Funding Amount Comparison - Preliminary allocation is \$114,00, which is \$15, 326 less than last year's allocation. The .5 social worker position which is funded by Title I will no longer be funded by Title I; instead, the funding will be given to schools to decide how to use.
