A. Budget and Staffing Approval

We expect to have 50+ more students in the 20-21 school year. Schools receive \$110 per student based on ADA. The Projected 20-21 Section 6 Allocation is based on the 18-19 attendance. We will receive 1.4 ELL teachers next year. The GT position will be 1.0. World Language was fully funded again. We'll use that for Spanish. We are also receiving about \$133,000 from Title I. The committee reviewed the 20-21 Section 6 budget.

Action: C. Hart made a motion to approve the 20-21 Section 6 Budget. S. Williams seconded the motion. All were in favor.

The committee reviewed the 20-21 projected staffing. We will be funded to staff 25 homeroom teachers. Mr. Marsh proposed buying 3 more to give us 28 teachers. Mr. Marsh proposed adding 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade teachers for the 20-21 school year. We would need 6 specials classes next year. Mr. Marsh proposed a 6th special with .8 librarian. Mr. Marsh proposed adding a .7 intervention teacher.

Action: The council reviewed the staffing numbers proposed. V. Deep made a motion to approve. C. Hart seconded the motion. All were in favor.
