- B. **Hybrid Service Model Options** - Mr. Marsh met with each grade level to discuss teacher priorities. He shared the priorities of the teachers with the council. Mr. Marsh shared four hybrid instructional models with the council. The council read the highlights of each model including the “Positives” and “Questions/Concerns.” Mr. Marsh also shared the teacher survey about which model is preferred. Looking at the options and the survey, the council agreed that Option 1 and Option 2 were the most viable options. The council suggested that Option 1 and Option 2 are planned out with more detail, giving a better picture of what the schedule would look like.
- C. **NTI 2DL Parent Feedback** - Mr. Marsh shared the parent survey on NTI 2DL. Some of the highlights: parents feel like communication is going well.
- D. **First Quarter Grading** - Sandersville will be using Teacher Ease standards based reporting for 20/21, however, the company will not have the program ready for our first quarter reporting. Teachers will create a narrative and summary for parents.  
**Action: The council agreed that teachers should provide a narrative and summary for a report card for the first quarter. M. Marsh made a motion to approve the teacher-created reports. T. Chastain seconded the motion. All were in favor.**
