A. Section 6 Budget Review - Mr. Marsh reviewed the budget and offered an opportunity for questions and discussion. Mr. Marsh expressed interest in getting feedback from teachers about classroom materials/school supplies and technology that will be needed next year. A. 21-22 Staffing Scenarios and Discussion - Mr. Marsh explained that he got feedback from all teachers about our school's greatest need for next year. He sent out a Google Form with two

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open-ended questions. 1. Explain our school's greatest staffing priorities for the 21-22 school year. 2. Provide evidence to support the need.

Mr. Marsh summarized feedback for the Instructional Committee and shared specific comments.

Notes from Staffing Scenario 1:

1. Art and Library positions will be staffed at .8 until RTA and MAF grant money comes in. Then they will each be staffed at 1.0.
2. The school will owe about \$61,000 for Scenario 1. We will be able to use grant money, Sharktime money, and Day 4 money to pay the balance.

The Instructional Committee voted unanimously for Scenario 1 - to hold steady with last year's staffing approved staffing minus the 0.8 intervention. The council was given the opportunity to ask questions and had a discussion about how to best spend our staffing budget. T. Chastain expressed a need for more ELL instructors. The council agreed to staff 2.0 ELL for 21-22. That is a 0.4 increase than the proposed option. The section 6 proposed was shared through email and approved.

Action: C. Wells made a motion to approve the Scenario/Option 1 with the addition of 0.4 ELL. T. Johnson seconded the motion. All were in favor.

- B. Sandersville Summer Ignite Updates** - Mrs. Williams shared that she created a FAQ for parents and teachers. The approved proposal was sent to the district and we are waiting for their feedback.

- A. KPREP Items & Test Times for Grades 3-5** - All KY schools will be taking KPREP, but it will be a condensed version. The timeframe and number of sessions will be much more manageable for schools and allow instruction to continue.
