- D. **ESS Proposal** - S. Williams shared a proposal for a group of ELL students to receive specialized instruction from May 25 - June 7 9:30-12:00. The focus will be reading. T. Chastain made a motion to approve the ESS Proposal with the caveat that food may not be covered by ESS funds. V. Deep seconded the motion. All were in favor.
Action: The council approved the ESS Proposal for May 25-June 7, 2021.
- E. **Chromebook Purchase - \$8,760** for 30 14in. Chromebooks. These will replace the desktops in the lab. There were no objections from the council. T. Johnson made a motion to approve the purchase of 30 Chromebooks. C. Wells seconded the motion. All were in favor.
