Policy Area: Curriculum

The seven critical attributes (a.) instructional practices, b.) assessment, c.) multi-age/multi-ability grouping, d.) professional teamwork/development, e.) parent involvement, f.) transition, and g.) leadership) shall be incorporated in Squires School's Primary Program through the implementation of diverse groupings. Flexible grouping and regrouping of children will allow for vertical as well as horizontal learning while maintaining continuous progress and meeting individual student needs. It is the Council's expectation that meaningful multi-age activities will take place in all single or multi graded classrooms on a daily basis.
