1. **ITEM** – Approval of Agenda and Minutes from September 6, 2018  
The agenda and minutes accepted as presented. Sally Adams made a motion to accept and David Scholl seconded the motion.
  
2. **ITEM** - No public were in attendance.
  
3. **ITEM** – School/Council Updates  
Mr. Scholl shared the good news from LHS. Laurel Regnier is using the Energy Award money to purchase new refrigerators for the building.  
Our Theatre Department put on Taste of Sunrise in both English and American Sign Language. It was excellent.  
Our LHS Price of the Bluegrass Marching Band is getting ready for Regionals and looking forward to State.  
Mr. Royster now has over 300 viewers on his Vlog and the response from staff and students is positive  
Laura Gravitt nominated one of our students, Savannah Cooper, for the Philanthropy Award and was chosen. She is allowed to take 2 guests and Mrs. Gravitt and Mrs. Clemons will accompany her to the luncheon on November 2. Savannah is a true inspiration to everyone.

Sally Adams shared that LHS has 8 Semi-finalists for National Merit Scholarships this year.  
Mr. Scholl shared that he received great feedback from our graduates. They have been well prepared while here at LHS and college is going very smooth for them.  
Monthly Field Trip report for the past month was shared.
  
4. **ITEM** – ESS Plan for 2018-2019  
Mr. Scholl presented the plan for ESS this year. We have the same structure that we had last year and feel this really works for our students. The budget was late this year in being released from the district. We are serving 1200 students who need extra help as well as students with D's and F's. We are finding that fewer kids are falling in the cracks, and the ESS program is being successful. Sally Adams made a motion to accept the ESS plan as presented and Sophie Schwab seconded the motion. Motion carried.

5. **ITEM** – Update on School Accountability

Mr. Jacobs shared a power point illustrating the scores LHS received. Mr. Jacobs discussed the breakdown of numbers and what that means to Lafayette HS. The high schools have 3 indicators: Proficiency, Transition Readiness, and Graduate Rate. Lafayette has done a great job in getting our students graduated and that helped our scores greatly. We still have some work in working with our GAP studies and areas on our TSI Status. Lafayette is the only high school that is not TSI status.

6. **ITEM** - Committee Policy

This is the second reading of the policy, and there were a few changes in the wording of the committees so there would not be confusion on the titles. Mr. Jacobs will present this information to the IL's and membership should be complete next week.

Sophie Schwab made a motion to approve the Committee Policy, and David Scholl seconded the motion. Motion carried.

7. **ITEM** – Budget Review

Mr. Jacobs reviewed the Sec 6 Budget. We are sitting at \$139,000 currently and most of that budget has been allocated for classroom supplies. We will hopefully carry forward 10% as a cushion for next year. We also expect to have other monies come in from 2<sup>nd</sup> month adjustments and fees paid by students. Stakeholders have expressed a desire to order more chrome books so that every student in the building as well as the teachers have access to a chrome book. Technology money is budgeted for this purpose.

Sally Adams made a motion for the meeting to be adjourned. Meeting adjourned at 6:19 p.m.
