4. Beyond the Core Initiative

The district has challenged LHS to increase the number of students taking AP classes. We will be working over the next few months to come up with a plan. We will discuss why the students are not taking AP courses and try to create better access for all students. We currently have 19 AP courses offered at LHS. It was suggested the barriers for taking an AP course be eliminated, i.e. prereqs. Ms. Trammell shared a concern that we maintain the integrity of the courses in the process. The district is offering financial support for staffing. Our actions as a school will be to encourage students to enroll, increase average of 1% each year, focus on diversity. We also need to remember to support the family decision in taking AP classes with students in extracurricular activities and time management. Mr. Jacobs will follow-up with SBDM at the next meeting.

5. ITEM – Monthly Budget and Staffing Review

- SEC 6 Budget Update - Not a lot of change since last month. We have already started working on 2019-2020 Budget.
- Staffing update – We now are fully staffed as of today.
