**I. Approval of Agenda and Approval of Minutes on January 3 and January 16, 2019**

**III. School Updates**

Mr. Scholl submitted the Good News from LHS.

- Our Wrestling Team hosted the Regional Tournament here at LHS and did well.

#### **IV. Parent/Family Involvement and Wellness Committee**

Mr. Scholl shared the committee met on February 6 and set up the framework. The policies were revised as requested by the State. We will be having Wellness Wednesdays twice a month. Also, we are having a weight loss challenge during February and March. Our Biometric Screenings GO 365 is scheduled for March 19. Also LHS will be reviving the Walking Club that will need after school. Mrs. Howard also offers a YOGA class to all staff on Monday right after school.

#### **V. Staffing Updates**

Mr. Jacobs shared the Budget and Staffing for 2019-2020. Our projected enrollment is 2303 students which is an increase to where we are now. We will be staffed at 98% of the projection to prevent overstaffing. Day 4 numbers will correct that to 100%. Ms. Heilig asked if the 2% would increase our staffing numbers if we start out at 98%. Mr. Jacobs shared it is hard to add staff on Day 4 as it is hard on the students to switch classes.

The end of February we will receive our allocation projections for SEC 6 budget for next year. We are currently working on our budgets at this time. We are having a Budget Committee meeting on February 20, and we will be working from last year's budget.

#### **VI. Budget Update**

The Sec 6 budget was presented. There are not a lot of changes. We will have \$30,000 in surplus and an additional \$20,000 carry forward monies.

The badges are going well. The metal detectors will be here soon. The projected date is March 18, 2019.
