IV. New Club Proposal – Boys Volleyball

Mr. Jacobs asked for a motion to approve the Club team. Bryson Perry made a motion, and Sophie Schwab seconded the motion. The motion was carried.

V. Monthly Budget and Staffing Review

There were no questions or changed in our SEC 6.

Staffing changes – we had an English position that we had to post in December. We were fortunate and we got a really good teachers. We were able to fill quickly.

Jen Brown, our clerical in the front office, is no longer with us. We posted the position, and it was hard to bring someone new in and training to hit the ground running on January 6. We have a part time person that was interested in filling the position for the remainder of the year, and then we will repost it in the summer. We are using a half a clerical position to purchase other items.

We now have more money to budget due to the left over clerical position.

Mr. Jacobs shared his initial idea of buying 10 more IFP for the remainder of the building. Mr. Perry shared that the departments are buying individual chrome books for their teachers. This has really transformed their work and has made a huge impact. Mr. Perry's idea was to get a touchscreen chrome book for each teacher in the building. Teachers can print from the chrome books as well. Mr. Jacobs hope this will be a great boost for our staff and help the teachers. The approximate cost is \$45,000. This will not use all the allocated monies we have. Mr. Royster inquired if each room would have a hard drop because the WIFI is sketchy at times. This would be an addition not a replacement of the desktops. Mr. Jacobs asked for approval of this plan so he can take it and run it past the IL's. Everyone feels like this is a strong program and would like to approve through SBDM. Richard Royster made a motion to approve the plan to provide every teacher receive a chrome book. Maria Cahill seconded the motion. The motion carried.
