Tips For Creating Successful Readers

- Invite a child to read with you everyday.
- Point to words as you read to help your child understand reading moves from left to right.
- Read a favorite book over and over again.
- Read stories with rhyming words and phrases that repeat.
- Discuss meanings of new words.
- Stop and ask questions about what is happening in the pictures.
- Read from a variety of books including, fairy tales, song books, poems, and informational stories.
